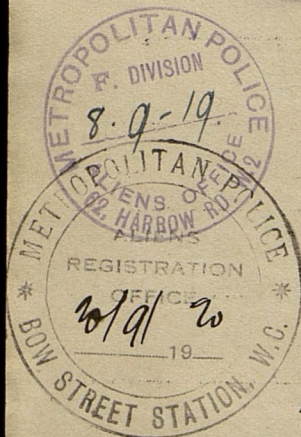
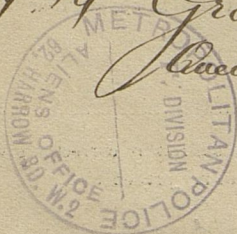

## NOTICE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS BOOK.

---

1. If you intend changing your residence temporarily or otherwise, you should, before moving, inform the Police of the District you are leaving, and on arrival at the new residence, inform the Police of that District also, as soon as possible.
2. Should you change your occupation, place of business, or status as regards marriage, you should inform the Police of your District within 48 hours.
3. You must produce this Identity Book when so required by any officer or by any soldier or sailor engaged on sentry patrol or other similar duty or by any aliens officer or police constable.

**Failure to observe these regulations renders the offender liable to be detained in custody and to fine or imprisonment.**

### PENALTY.

Any person who uses an Identity book relating to any person other than himself (or herself), or, in filling in or attesting the particulars in an Identity book, or for the purpose of obtaining an Identity book, makes any false statement or false representation, or who forges, alters, or tampers with an Identity book is liable to six months' imprisonment or a fine of £100.
