NOTICE.

1. Subject to the reservation that tourists are exempted from the obligations mentioned in items (6) to (8) below, every registered foreigner is required :—

- (1) on the demand of any Registration Officer or Magistrate, or any Police Officer not below the rank of head constable, to produce this certificate and his passport or such other proof of identity as may be required of him by such Magistrate or officer ;
- (2) on arrival at any hotel or other place where travellers are accommodated, to record his name and nationality in a register maintained for the purpose and to make a separate arrival report in a prescribed form ;
- (3) before leaving any hotel, to record in the register referred to above the date of his departure and the place to which he is proceeding ;
- (4) prior to departing by sea or air from India to furnish to the agents of the vessel or aircraft in question or to the Registration Officer of the port of embarkation a departure report showing certain prescribed particulars ;
- (5) on departure from India, to surrender his Certificate of Registration to the Registration Officer of the port or place at which he proposes to leave India if his departure is by sea or air, and, in any other case, to the Registration Officer of the district from which he commences his journey for the purpose of leaving India ;
- (6) to report to the Registration Officer of the district in which his registered address is situated,—
 - (a) if he is absent from his registered address for a continuous period of one month or more, his current address and every subsequent change of address including his return to his registered address,
 - (b) if he proposes to change his registered address or to leave India, the particulars of his new address and the date of the proposed change or departure, and
 - (c) any circumstances which in any way affect the accuracy of any of the particulars set out in his Certificate of Registration ;
- (7) on effecting any change of residence or address to a district other than the district in which his registered address is situated, to report his presence to the Registration Officer of that district within 24 hours of his arrival therein ;
- (8) if he stays for more than 24 hours at any place (other than a hotel or other premises where travellers are accommodated) in any district other than the district in which his registered address is situated, to report his presence in that other district to the Registration Officer thereof.

2. Failure to comply with the foregoing provisions will render the holder of this Certificate liable to imprisonment or fine or both.
