

ХУДОЖНИК РЕРИХ — КАНДИДАТ НА ПРЕМИЮ НОБЕЛЯ

Из Парижа сообщают, что факультет международного права Парижского университета и особая комиссия из выдающихся деятелей представили в норвежскую комиссию по присуждению премий Нобеля кандидатуры пяти лиц, заслуживающих этой премии за деятельность в деле насажения мира. В числе этих лиц: Франк Келлог, б. французский премьер Эррио, лидер английской рабочей партии Макдональд, французский делегат в Лиге Наций сенатор Жувенель и художник Николай Рерих.

Это — первый случай, когда кандидатом на премию Нобеля по этому отделу является художник и ученый. В докладе комиссии отмечается что за 39 лет своей деятельности Рерих в своих литературных и художественных трудах, в лекциях, исследованиях, картинах проповедывал идеи международного сближения и всеобщего братства. Его работы проникли в далекие углы Азии, и он заложил семена этих идей в 22-х странах всего мира.

KELLOGG NAMED FOR NOBEL PRIZE

MacDonald, Herriot and Roerich Among Others Mentioned.

The Roerich Museum in Manhattan said last night it had received word from Paris that the Presentation Committee had nominated the following five persons as candidates for the Nobel Peace Prize:

Secretary of State Kellogg.

Senateur Juvenal of France.

Ramsay Macdonald, former British Premier.

Edouard Herriot, former French Premier.

Prof. Nicholas Roerich.

The museum said Roerich was recommended because "through his writing, paintings and lectures he has extended his influence for peace to 21 countries."

FIVE IN NOBEL PRIZE CONTEST

Cable advices received from Paris at the Roerich Museum, No. 313 West One Hundred and Fifth street, yesterday stated five names have been submitted to the Nobel Commission for the Peace Prize. Two Americans, Professor Nicholas Roerich and Secretary of State Kellogg are among those submitted to the committee, which is comprised of members of the Norwegian Parliament.

Others mentioned for the prize are Senator Jouvenal, of France; Ramsey MacDonald, and former Premier Herriot, of France..

Professor Roerich's name was presented officially through the Department of International Law of Paris University. This is the first time, it is said, that an artist and scientist has been nominated for the award. Professor Roerich's work in art and culture in more than twenty-one countries was reviewed.

ROERICH NOMINATED FOR PEACE AWARD

Artist and Scientist Named
With Four Prominent States-
men for the Nobel Prize

KELLOGG ALSO PRESENTED

Senator Jouvenel, Edouard Herriot
and Ramsay MacDonald Are
the Other Nominees

According to a cablegram received from Paris by the Roerich Museum, 310 Riverside Drive, the names submitted to the Nobel Commission for the Peace Prize, which comprises members of the Norwegian Parliament at Oslo, include those of Secretary Kellogg of the United States, Senator Jouvenel of France, Professor Nicholas Roerich, former Premier Ramsay MacDonald of Great Britain and former Premier Herriot of France.

Professor Roerich's name was presented officially through the Department of International Law of the University of Paris, and the committee of presentation comprised officials and members of the universities of various countries. As far as is known, this is the first time that an artist and scientist has been nominated as a candidate for the peace award, on the basis that efforts for international peace through art and culture have brought about better understanding of international relations.

In presenting the name of Professor Roerich, the committee of presentation states, among other things:

"Since 1890, Nicholas Roerich, through his writings, through his lectures, researches, paintings and through the many fields into which his broad personality has led him, has forcefully expounded the teaching of international brotherhood. His propaganda for peace has penetrated into more than twenty-one countries and the recognition of its influence has been testified by the widely different activities which have invited his assistance.

"As an artist, one of the greatest that history has produced, his paintings have illustrated the great volume of beauty and spiritual light symbolized by his teaching. The significance of their universal appeal is seen in the foundation in New York of the Roerich Museum that the people might have permanent recourse to his teachings.

"We firmly believe that eventual and lasting international peace will come only through the education of the people and through that steady and impressive propaganda for brotherhood created by culture, by poetry and by beauty in every field. The works of Roerich have, for the last thirty years, been one of the great summons to the world for love among men."
