SIMLA, October 1: The Posts and Telegraphs department will issue a commemoration stamp on the occasion of the birth centenary of Prof. Nicholas Roerich, the well-known Russian painter, archaeologist and writer, on October 9.

An elaborate programme has been drawn up to celebrate the centenary at Naggar in Kulu district on that day. (Prof. Roerich, who spent most of his life in the Himalayan region, died in Kulu on December 13, 1947). The celebrations, which will be highlighted by an exhibition of his paintings at Kulu on October 11, will be inaugurated by the Chief Minister, Dr. Y. S. Parmar.

A similar exhibition will be held in Simla on October 15 and 16.

India will issue a special one-rupee stamp on Professor Nicholas Roerich on October 9, his birth centenary. The motif of the horizontal stamp will be a medallion of Professor Roerich.

Nicholas Roerich, artist, scholar and explorer, loved India. His paintings are steeped in Indian themes, especially the Himalayas.

At the inauguration of Nicholas Roerich's posthumous exhibition in Delhi in 1947, Jawaharlal Nehru said: "They (the great Indian mountains) remind us of so much in our history, our thought, our cultural and spiritual heritage, so much not merely of the India of the past but of something that is permanent and eternal about India, that we cannot help feeling a great sense of indebtedness to Nicholas Roerich who has enshrined that spirit in these magnificent canvases."



NEW DELHI, Oct. 3.

A special centenary postage stamp on Prof. Nicholas Roerich, the artist scholar, explorer and educationist who made India his home, will be released by the Posts and Telegraphs department on October 9.

The department has decided wisely to release the stamp, not with a fanfare in Delhi, but at Naggar in the picturesque Kulu Valley of Himachal Pradesh, where he had settled down. The first day cancellation will be provided, for the first time, by a sub-post office at Naggar.

Prof. Roerich, who was born in 1874 at St. Petersburg in Russia, was a great lover of Indian culture and heritage and was the father of Suetslav Roerich, husband of Devika Rani, the first lady of Indian screen. The horizontal stamp of Re. 1 denomination has been based on a medallion of Nicholas Roerich done by Henry Dropsy.



India's first Se-tenat stamp

Two special postage stamps in the denominations of 25 paise each in 'Se-tenat' format were issued on October 9 on the occasion of the centenary of Mathura Museum. One of the stamps shows a lady playing a flute under a tree full of flowers and the other Vidyadhare hovering in the air with a garland in his hands. This is the first time that India issued a Se-tenat stamp. Originally, one stamp was scheduled for the Museum Centenary.

ROERICH STAMP

A special postage stamp in the denomination of Re. 1- was issued on October 9 in honour of Prof. Nicholas Roerich. The design of the stamp is horizontal, and the issue marks the centenary of the Professor. A medallion of Nicholas Roerich done by Henry Dropsy has been adopted as the motif of the stamp. A special function was held at Naggar in Himachal Pradesh for the first day sale. Bombay also witnessed a function.

CHILDREN'S DAY

There is a change in the new issue programme for the rest of

the year. Two stamps will be issued on November 14 — National Children's Day. One will honour 25 years of UNICEF in India and the other — the National Chil-

dren's Day. The special features of these stamps are that both are designed by children, including the First Day Cover. The UNICEF stamp design is

based on a prize winning drawing from the International Children's Art Competition held in Paris a few years back. Amita Shah, a girl from Baroda, won a prize for her painting which has been adopted for the UNICEF stamp in India. The Children's Day stamp is also designed by a child from a Delhi School. Earlier, the P&T Dept. had issued designs by children for the Children's Day stamps.

The first Children's Day stamps were issued in 1957 when a set of three stamps appeared. The theme for the three stamps was Education, Recreation and Nutrition. It followed with a 15 nP. stamp each

With the increase of the other stamps, the Children's Day issue which appeared faithfully all these years was discontinued. In 1966 a 15 nP stamp was issued depicting a child and a dove. The INPEX 1970 stamps included a design depicting a boy and a girl working on their stamp collection. The stamps were released on the occasion of the first National Exhibition. The 1971 Children's Day stamp, in 20 p denomination, represented a painting designed by a child artist — an entry in the Shanker's International Child Art Competition.

Several postal administrations have been lately using stamp designs done by children.

MARCONI STAMP

The Marconi stamp in the denomination of Rs. 2 will be issued on December 12, 1974. The stamp will depict his portrait. The Dance Series will be issued in early 1975. The stamp for Ram Charit Manas has been deferred for a date in November.

The revised programme for 1974 is as follows: Archaeological Museum, Mathura — 9th October (two stamps — 25p each); Prof. Nicholas Roerich — 9th October (Re. 1-); Mahavira — 13th November (25p); Children's Day—14th November (25p); UNICEF — 14th November (25p); Territorial Army

in 1958 and 1959. The 1960 the 15 nP. Children's Day stamp had Children's Health as a theme. In the same year a 15 nP stamp was issued for the UNICEF and depicted Children greeting the U.N. emblem. The 1961 stamp was again a 15 nP denomination and depicted a boy at work. The 1962 stamp of 15 nP depicted a flag held by an adult passing on to the youth. Two hands and a flag make the design. The theme for the 1963 stamp was "meals".

 Roerich was. Which is why
 it is inadequate. A good idea
 goes a long way if there is a
 little imagination to give it
 a boost. As such, the P & T
 Dept. could have used a little
 more of the uncommon sense
 to make the stamp at least
 noteworthy enough to de-
 serve its subject. India has
 millions of stamps and a
 large proportion of them are
 of heads. Heads with crowns
 were removed by indepen-
 dent India only to be sub-
 stituted by heads without
 crowns with beards without
 beards; with hats — but
 very monotonously heads.
 And Roerich's has been ad-
 ded to the list. Surely a
 reprint of one of his magni-
 ficent mountain_scapes, or a
 copy of one of his sketches
 would have been more attrac-
 tive as well as evidence of
 his genius. And if a head
 was that necessary it could
 have been an inset. The P
 & T Department should shed
 its heady obsession.
