It is a plea for a mystical merging

education of the heart rather than the  
material education of the mind. Many  
of these surcharged bits of thought are  
subtle and profound and awaken the  
reader to an awareness of hitherto  
unsuspected spiritual truths whose ef-  
fect can only be to elevate the spirit.  
Not all of these apothegms are imme-  
diately understandable to the novice,  
but a prolonged probing and weighing  
of their contents brings its own re-
