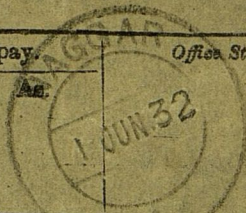


Dear Sir ,
