Lichtmann, both sworn to June 25, the petition herein, verified June 6, 1936, the answer to the petition herein, verified June 12, 1936, in support of the said motion; and the affidavit of Louis L. ORDERED that the said motion for a stay be and the same hereby is in all respects granted; and it is further

ORDERED that pending the final determination of this special proceeding the respondents and the corporation, Master Institute of United Arts, Inc., its officers, agents, servants and employees, be and they hereby are stayed and enjoined from carrying into effect



or acting upon the certain resolution purported to have been adopted at a purported meeting of the Board of Trustees of said Master Institute of United Arts, Inc., ~~July~~ on June 5, 1936, in so far as they relate to the petitioners, or any of them, Urusvati Himalayan Research Institute, and Roerich Museum Press, and from disturbing or in any way interfering with the peaceable and quiet possession by the petitioners, Urusvati Himalayan Research Institute, Sophie Schaffran, and Roerich Museum Press of the rooms and apartments which they or any of them occupied or occupy in the premises owned by Master Institute of United Arts, Inc., and from interfering with or in any way disturbing the conduct by the petitioners of the school of Master Institute of United Arts, Inc. or the Roerich Museum Press, and from interfering with the use and possession by the petitioners of the rooms, facilities, files and space used by them in their conduct of the school of Master Institute of United Arts, Inc. or the Roerich Museum Press, upon condition that the petitioners serve and file herein, within five days from the entry hereof, an undertaking, in form as required by statute, executed by two good and sufficient sureties, or in the alternative, by a surety company, in the sum of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars.
