and I acknowledge with thanks receipt of your reply  
as follows:

"Do you refer to deposition for cost or tax return or other  
declaration Stop If former as court appoints commissioner  
suggest you cabling attorney arrange appointment Consul  
Karachi - Amconsul". (Though this wire was sent by you  
on the 25th at 10.55 a.m. it reached me only on the 27th  
at 12.30 p.m. because owing to snow avalanches in the  
hills here our postal and telegraphic service was inter-  
rupted for a few days. "

Following your kind suggestion I have cabled to my  
attorneys in New York asking them at the same time to  
have the date of the deposition in Karachi postponed for  
a fortnight, because of Madame Roerich's illness.

There is always risk of a telegram not being delivered if a full and definite address is not given, in the first instance.
