N Y M P H A E A S

(Water Lilies)

The beauty and interest of any garden is considerably enhanced by providing accommodation for representative collection of water loving subject.

The cultivation of small growing Nymphaea and Aquatics in tubs is one of the simplest form of gardening, stout tubs should be selected, about 18 inches in depth and about 28 inches across, such a receptacle will accommodate one Nymphaea and 2 small Aquatics.

The tubs should be sunk 2 to 3 inches below the level of the surrounding land.

For tub cultivation only the smallest species and varieties can be grown. In planting arrange for one inch of well-decayed cow manure or two ounces of coarse bonemeal to go at the bottom and cover with 8 to 9 inches of heavy loam (Meadow loam for preference, excluding all roots and vegetable matters), having same well rammed, plant while the tub is empty, cover with 3 inches of water and add as the plants progress in growth, in normal weather you should be able to fill your tub, in 4 or 5 weeks.
