Prof. Nicholas Roerich was born in Russia in 1874 at Pertersbourg. Prof. Roerich received training, as a lawyer, historian and archaeologist and at the Academy of Arts.

He achieved world recognition as an artist at an early age. His paintings were exhibited, throughout Europe and America and he was honoured by many governments and learned bodies. Several Museums were dedicated his art.

Inspite of his enormous activity his range and out put of works is note worthy. Number runs over some 7,000 paintings besides large frescoes in Churches and public buildings. Many of his canvases are dedicated to Himalayas. They were a constant sources of inspiration to him and he was known as "Master of Mountains". The numerous paintings of Himalayan landscapes, reveal his ability of conveying their colours and moods, soaring, heights and the magnificient beauty of these cosmic mountains.

Prof. Nicholas Roerich died at Kulu, on 13th December, 1947, after spending most of his life in Himalayan India.

This exhibition which was formally inaugurated by Shri N. P. Mathur, I. A. S., Chief Commissioner, Chandigarh Administration, to commemorate the birth Centenary Celebrations of Prop. Nicholas Roerich on 9th October, 1974, at Government Museum, Chandigarh, is now arranged at Government Museum, Madras as a Circulating Exhibition under the joint auspices of these two leading Museums at Chandigarh and Madras, to promote the growth of art activities between Museums.

The exhibition consists of photographic reproductions, colour transpariencies, and excerpts from Nicholas Roerich's writings.
