MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this 16th day of February 1945
Between Professor Nicholas de Roerich (hereinafter called "the
Author"), for himself, his executors, administrators and assigns
of the one part and MESSRS THE KITABISTAN, ALLAHABAD, (hereinafter
called "the Publishers") for themselves, their administrators, successors, and assigns, of the other part. WHEREAS the Author has
written a literary work at present entitled "HIMAVAT" (hereinafter
called "the work") which the author desired the Publishers to publish,
now it is hereby agreed between the parties hereto as follows:-

- l. The Author guarantees to the Publishers that the said work is in no way whatever a violation of any existing copyright, and that it contains nothing of a libellous or Scandalous character, and the Author agrees to indemnify the Publishers from all suits, Claims, and proceedings, damages, and costs which may be made, taken, or incurred by or against them on the ground that the work is an infringment of copyright, or contains anything libellous or scandalous.
  - 2. In consideration of the payment hereinafter mentioned, the Publishers shall during the legal term of unrestricted copyright have the exclusive right of producing and publishing the work or any portion of it throughout the world, and the Author shall not publish or allow to be published any abridgment, portion, translation or printed dramatised version of the work without the consent of the Publishers, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld.
  - 3. The Publishers shall at their own risk and expense and with due diligence produce and publish the work and use their best endeavours to sell the same. The Publishers shall have the entire control of the production, publication, sale and terms of sale of the work.
  - 4. The Publishers shall pay to the Author (subject as mentioned herein and except on any copies herein specially excepted) a royalty of 10% (Ten per cent) of the published price of the copies sold.
  - 5. In the event of the Publishers being successful in arranging for the copyright publication of the work in foreign countries they shall pay the Author 50% (Fifty per cent) of the royalties or sums realised by them after deduction of foreign income-tax.
  - 6. In the event of the sale of any serial rights in the work or in any portion of the net proceeds of any sale of such rights to the Author and 50% (Fifty per cent) to the Publishers.
  - 7. In the event of the sale by the Publishers of any translation or foreign rights in the work or in any portion of it the Publishers shall pay the Author 50% (Fifty per cent) of the net proceeds of such sales.
  - 8. In the event of any fees being received by the Publishers for permission to reprint any portion of the work or in the event of any other sums being received by the Publishers in connection of the work not hereinbefore mentioned and derived from the sale of the copies of the work, the Publishers shall pay the Author 50% (Fifty per cent) of the net fees or sums which they receive.

- 9. On the day of first publication of the work the Publishers shall deliver to the Author free of charge 6 presentation copies of the work for personal use, and the Author shall have right to purchase further copies of the work for personal use, but not for sale, at threefourth of the published price.
- 10. No royalty shall be payable to the Author upon any copies presented to the Author or upon any copies sent out for review to the press or given away in the interest of the work, or upon any copies destroyed by fire or in transit or otherwise damaged.
- 11. The Publishers shall make up semi-annually a statement of all sales of copies of the work or of rights in the work sold under this agreement upto June 30th and December 31st. of each year and shall deliver the same to the Author together with any monies shown therein to be due to the Author, within three months hereafter.

12. The term "Publishers" throughout this Agreement shall be deemed to include the person or persons or Company for the time being carrying on the business of the said MESSRS THE KITABISTAN, under as well its present as any future style, and them or their respective administrators, successors or assigns, and the benefit of this agreement shall be transmissible accordingly.


