The speech by Dr.M. Ramesh, M.B.B.S., Chairman "The Indo-Bulgaria Friendship Association", Bangalore, on the occasion of "Bulgaria National Day Celebrations" on Friday, the 26th of September 1986.

Respected Chief Guests, Pattern, TheBoard of Members of the Association, Ladies and Gentlemen and Friends.

It is a pleasure to have an opportunity requested by the board of the society to talk on the glympses of the country Bulgaria and its Friendship with India in respect of the following points:

PEOPLES REPUBLIC OF BULGARIA

LOCATION AND SIZE: Peoples Republic of Bulgaria is a small country situated over a territory of 110,900 Sq.Kms with a population about One Crore. This country is situated in the continent of Europe. It has Grece in the South, Black Sea in the East, Yugoslavia in the West and Rumania in the North.

PEOPLE WITH NO RIGHTS: The end of the 14th and the beginning of the 15th Century witnessed tragic events in the Balkan, Peninsula, the individual feudal principalities constituting the Balkan Peninsula were not sufficiently strong, that their rulers were constantly engaged in hostilities among themselves, the Ottoman hordes, conqured the whole Peninsula. After a long struggle it was with great joy and enthusiam that the Bulgarian People celebreated the Historical Victory on September 9th, 1944 which brought about deep revolutions in the life of the country. They made greate progress in the different fields.

AGRICULTURE: Small Patches of land have been ploughed over, so as to merge into large fields of the co-operative farms which were later further integrated into the Druster Agro Industial Complex. The Druster Agro. Industrial complex is a unique Agricultural enterprise in the country. It has pooled the land of the entire District which allows for a greater degree of concentration and specialisation of agriculture for the introduction of new Industrial technologies, for the closer connection of land cultivation with the end product and its processing. Enterprises such as the poultry farm, dairies, the canneries, the wine factories are directly dependent on the work of the complex and provide a model of a new way of organising agricultural production,

which is increasingly becoming a type of industrial production. The important crops of Bulgaria are wheat, oats, Barley, Maize and Fruits, River Danube provides irrigational facilities.

INDUSTRY (NATIONAL ECONOMY): Prior to Bulgaria's liberation from fasciest and capitalist rule, her economy stood on a very low level. The Industries were under developed. Agriculture was backward after independence Bulgaria turned into an advanced Industrial cum-agricultural country. Industry achieved immense success and occupied a dominant place in the economy.

The structure of industry was improved along with traditional branches, new ores came into being such as dremining industry, metallurgical Industry, Chemical Industry and Machinary Industries. The important Industries of Bulgaria are Electricity, Coke, Asphelt, Pig Iron and tools, Tractor seed drills, Nitrogen fertilisers, sulphuric Acid, Cement Catton Fabrics, Footwear, Fruit Canning, Dairy Farming, and Meat Packing. Bulgaria has built a large petro-chemical pants at Bourgas and pleven. The rapid economic development of the country is a stable foundation for raising the living standards of the people. The constitution guarantees every citizen the right to labour. There is no unemployment in this country, 60% of the village homes have been built in the last three decades.

EDUCATION, SCIENCE, CULTURE: Bulgaria is a country with rich traditions in culture. She has a wide net work of Childrens establishments and schools. 7,580 Klindergartens for nearly 400,000 Children, 4,485 schools attended by 1,530,000 students, 26 higher institutions, vocational, technical and Secondary. Special Education occupies a prominent place in the countries Educational system. Bulgarian culture is developing as a national in farm and socialist in content culture. It is managed by the committee for culture and by the councils for art and culture on a local leve, based on the principles of dual social and state guidance. This has helped the promotion of culture throught the country. The oress the radio and the television are operating on an extremely large scale. Theatres-55, including 36 dramas, 7 opera, 1 operetta and 11 puppet theatres. Cinemas-3, 689 with an audiance of 114 million. Museums-181. Reading Clubs-4,267, Libraries-10,500.

Amateur art is very popular in the country. Hundreds of the thousands of working people participated in amateur art companies. Bulgaria is a country of talented writers, signers,

artists, sculptors, who are enriching the democratic cultural traditions of the people with valuable works of socialist realisum. Bulgarian Literature cinema theatre and opera singing have won Wide international recongition. Stone inscriptions and ancient manuscripts which have preserved important information about the speech of the first Bulgarian state, contain the list of Names of the Bulagarian rulers, the inscriptions of Omurtag Khan, Tsar Simeon's Codex etc., According to the calendar, known to the scientists as proto-Bulgarian, it has been proved that this calendar anticipated, by thousands of years, the first calendars in China, India and Egypt served as a basis for them. The calendar reflects Bulgaria's ancient predecessor's ideas and knowledge about the surrounding world and the movement of the celestial bodies. It also evinces their understanding of regid laws governing our universe. The picture of a tortoise in the calender represents the oldest ideas of the world structure, common to both the American Indians and Hindu Mythology. The first metropolis Pliska was founded by the Bulgarian Khan Isperich. His successors turned it into a monumental for tress. Best preserved are thr ruins of the grand palace of Tsar Kr oum, built on an area of 4,718 sq.M, with a royal hall. The huge stone blocks which have remained in their place throughout the ages are the remindsent of the epoch of stern morality and a rigid moral code.

BULGRAIA A COUNTRY OF PEACE CO. OPERATION AND PROGRESS: Peoples republic of Bulgaria is pursuing a consistently democratic and peaceful policy in her foreign relations. Events of the last three decades have confirmed the justification, correctness and effectiveness in this policy, The people's Republic of Bulgaria together with the other Fraternal countries will be giving her full contribution in strengthening the unity, cohesion and defence potential of the Socialists community and working toward further strengthening and improvement of the organization of the Warsaw Treaty as a powerful deterrent against the aggressive policy of imperialism. Bulgaria is one of the founders of the Council for Mutual Economic Assistance (1949), The Bulgaria Soviet Treaty of Friendship. Co. operation and mutual Assistance was signed in 1948. Peoples Republic of Bulgraia is in line with the interests of India fighting for freedom and national independence for peace and social progress.
