Warsaw, March 23, 1933.

Finally I have got a definite answer from the Polish Government. The Polish government is unable to cover the expense of an exhibition of paintings just now, but as soon as it will be possible our government will send a representative exhibition of Polish art of the highest quality possible. Our government appreciates very much the opportunity given by the Roerich Museum. Meanwhile, it asks the Roerich Museum to exhibit Polish engravings and water colors. I shall bring the collection with me in June.....
