PEACE! The one path to human evolution! The one panacea for a world

corroded by the aftermath of war!

And to this hallowed peace—but one way! The path of tolerance, of understanding of man's striving, of cultural appreciation from man to man, nation to nation. In the belief that culture must be the great solvent of these assailing problems, that the lasting peace must come through education, through a return to the basic principle of human relationships, the Roerich Peace Pact and Roerich Peace Banner were created by Nicholas Roerich, leader of world culture, indefatigable toiler for the welfare of mankind.

Briefly, it provides that educational, artistic and scientific institutions, artistic and scientific missions, the personnel, property and collections of such institutions and missions shall be deemed neutral and inviolable in time of war or peace. In order to insure this, a Banner was designed by Professor Roerich which would wave over the monuments of culture, universities, museums and cathedrals, proclaiming

their inviolability.

The Roerich Peace Pact and Roerich Banner of Peace, applying as they do in war, pertain in far greater measure to peace. History has taught us that mankind has been united either by common hate or by common love. Hatred can lead only to destruction. A common love—ardent, invincible—for the achievements of the human spirit and human genius can alone gather all humanity into a League of Culture which will defy every inroad of intolerance, of desecration, of hate.

It is for this reason that the Roerich Banner of Culture represents one of the epochal possibilities of history. It is a call to all men and women to unite in safeguarding the steps of culture made by humanity through the ages; it is a tocsin calling all nations to combine in united vigilance, lest the milestones thus far achieved so laboriously and in such travail by the human race be defiled and annihilated.

For this reason the campaign for a fund of \$1,000,000 for the Roerich Peace Pact and Roerich Banner of Peace has been inaugurated. That through the collaboration of millions of individuals—in however modest a contribution—means shall be collected to raise up this bright flame of peace throughout the world, that men,

women and children shall be educated, united, brought together by the common love of culture!

To assure means for the collecting of this fund for the Roerich Banner of Peace, Nicholas Roerich has himself donated the reproductions of his masterpiece "Banner of Peace" and "Conflagration." These postcards enable each individual of however limited means to express his support of this measure and thus enlist their names in the League of Culture which should encircle the earth! Donations may also be made through the purchase of the Roerich Banner of Peace Annuals comprising the records of the history of this movement together with all data and opinions on the Banner of Peace. Donations of any sums may also be made to the Committee for the Banner of Peace.

The fund of \$1,000,000 is to be used in the following ways: towards spreading the world-wide support of the Roerich Peace Pact and Banner of Peace; towards the enlisting of the individuals and nations of the earth in this great League of Culture aimed to further the cause of world peace; towards the education of youth as well as adults in the appreciation of the cultures of other nations, and in the protections of the cultural treasures of mankind; towards the cataloguing, photographing and listing of all cultural treasures of the earth so that they remain recorded for all posterity; towards the marking of all the world's monuments of culture by this Banner.

The Committee for the Fund hereby makes its appeal to all men and women, to you who read this message. Do not fail this cause of peace! Accept a part of the responsibility for humanity's future! Contribute your share, however small, in whatever measure you are able. But join this imperative call for Peace through Culture that unitedly we may strive to fulfill the divine charge of BROTHERHOOD AMONG MEN!

FOREIGN AND AMERICAN EXHIBITIONS FUND

INTERNATIONAL ART CENTER OF ROERICH MUSEUM

EN years ago Nicholas Roerich, true prophet of the destiny of beauty, wrote: "The time for the construction of future culture is at hand. Before our eyes the revaluation of values is being witnessed. Amidst ruins of valueless banknotes, mankind has found the real value of the world's significance. The values of great art are victoriously traversing all storms of earthly commotions."

Last season—a decade after—three remarkable occurrences took place in the

International Art Center of Roerich Museum:

At the moment of the Brazilian Revolution, the first All-Brazilian Exhibition was opened in the International Art Center of Roerich Museum. The First All-Australian Exhibition was held in the International Art Center at the very moment when Australia was experiencing its most severe financial crisis.

At the moment of the Spanish Revolution, a Spanish exhibition by Don

José Segrelles was opened in the International Art Center.

Despite the fact that feeling at these moments ran high, the exhibitions were held with utmost veneration; no word of dissension was heard, only a call to harmony, and a pronunciation of the faith in art and beauty as the great unifying

force among nations.

In this remarkable instance of the prophecy of Nicholas Roerich and its fulfill-ment—repeated constantly in the history of the International Art Center—lies the most eloquent evidence of the unifying force of beauty, as of its contribution towards international understanding. It is for this reason that foreign and American exhibitions, the interchange of art through the nations, offers one of the greatest instruments in establishing finer world relationships.

The International Art Center—Corona Mundi—was founded by Nicholas Roerich for the purpose of spreading art appreciation to all men, and of promoting better international understanding through Beauty. In its intensive years of existence it has held exhibitions of the arts of diverse nations, not only in its own halls but has cooperated in sending exhibitions to museums, schools, libraries,

universities, communities, factories and even prisons!

It has inaugurated such exhibitions as those of the American Indian Paintings, Tibetan Tankas, Old Masters, Modern American Painting and Sculpture, Russian Ikons, Modern French Paintings and Modern German Paintings, South African Paintings and others, as well as numerous notable individual artists from all parts of the world.

Through its efforts it has brought to the United States for the first time a comprehensive Exhibition of Brazilian Artists, also the First All-Australian Exhibition. It has been one of the greatest forces in the West to widen the understanding of Tibetan and Asiatic arts through its exhibitions of Tibetan ikons and

art crafts gathered by the Roerich Central Asiatic Expedition.

With this in mind a Campaign for \$200,000 for the Fund of Foreign and American Exhibitions is now inaugurated. In order to enable every single man, woman and child to express their help to this cause, Professor Nicholas Roerich, founder of the International Art Center, has generously contributed the postcard reproduction of his painting "Saintly Guests," proceeds from the sale of which are

to go to this Fund.

The proceeds from this campaign are to be applied completely to arranging the exhibitions of foreign artists in the United States and of American artists in foreign countries; to the establishing of extension lectures and courses with these exhibitions, in order to diffuse greater knowledge of the art and cultures of foreign countries; to assisting museums and collectors in making additions to their collections of foreign art; to spreading these exhibitions in museums, schools, libraries, universities and even prisons; to infuse love of art in the young generations, and to employ all other means which shall contribute to the great cause outlined by Nicholas Roerich when he wrote: "And when we proclaim: Love, Beauty and Action, we know verily, that we pronounce the formula of the international language. And this formula, which now belongs to the Museum and Stage must enter every day life. The sign of beauty and action will open all sacred gates. Beneath the sign of beauty we walk joyfully. With beauty and action we conquer. Through beauty we pray. In beauty we are united. And now we affirm these words-not on the snow heights, but amidst the turmoil of the city. And realizing the path of true reality, we greet with a happy smile the future."

Viewing with gratification the results of these years of effort, in the cause of art, the International Art Center now appeals to those to whom the cause of culture is paramount, to contribute towards the extending of this great movement for finer international relationships through foreign and American exhibitions and

the interchange of art.

CAMPAIGN for \$1,000,000 WOMAN'S UNITY "SHARE OF CULTURE" FUND

N his article "Guard of the Mother of the World," Nicholas Roerich writes, "To enumerate the achievements of Womanhood, is to write the history of the world. To enumerate the ecstasies of illumination is to enumerate the vision of Womanhood. To study cooperation is to perceive the hand of Womanhood."

It was in this spirit, with the hope of uniting the world's Womanhood in a great force which would serve and aid human progress, that the Woman's Unity of Roerich Museum founded by Professor and Mme. Roerich, its Honorary Presidents, was begun. And it is in the following words that it has set forth the purposes of its work:

"It is with the vision of giving Woman her true place in the Era of the Great Mother, that the Woman's Unity of the Roerich Museum has been organized. In these days of cataclysms, human disunion and disintegration, a Voice must rise which calls to the resurrection of the spirit and the infusion of the fire of achievement into all life. And that voice should be the voice of womanhood. It is she who must raise the new banner of spirit, on which is inscribed 'Love, Knowledge and Beauty.'

"As a non-political world organization, its tenets must comprise striving toward the ennoblement and upliftment of all that pertains to true Culture in its world measure, and beyond conventional borders and prejudices.

"The purpose of the Woman's Unity is to unite women—those who feel the need of a true spiritual and cultural infusion into current life. It is they who must carry the banner of self-sacrifice and beauty, they who must constitute for humanity the example of true cooperation, who must raise the banner of the Great Heart of the Mother of the World."

To the end of making possible this great Unity of Women through the world, the Committee for the Fund for Woman's Unity "Share of Culture," has inaugurated a campaign for \$1,000,000 to provide means to carry on this universal cause.

In the enlisting of this Fund, Professor Roerich has generously donated all proceeds from the sale of the postcard reproductions of his paintings "Mother of the World" and "Queen of Heaven," which will go towards the cause. In addition,

the Share of Culture has been devised, enabling everyone to add his contribution. Gifts of any size will be welcomed by the Committee.

It will be the purpose to expend all donations to the fund for Woman's Unity in fulfilling the following purposes:

To unite the Women of all Countries, in the name of this ideal.

To introduce into life and sponsor in all measures, the cornerstones of Culture—the development of spirit and the broadest cooperation in every domain of Knowledge and Beauty in all countries.

To ennoble all manifestations of life and establish Art and Science as the most vital factors of development; to strengthen and enlighten family, social and State-life, and eventually to establish a center which may give advice and counsel in such problems.

To encourage the broadening of thought and of all creative faculties; to infuse ethical values into all fields of life as the most essential factor in the Education of the new generation.

If the Woman's Unity is apprised of any violation or neglect of cultural principles, it shall recognize the duty of bringing this to the attention of the Leaders of the institutions concerned, and even of appealing to public opinion.

As the establishment of true cooperation between men and women is one of the most vital conditions of culture, the Woman's Unity is not solely a woman's organization.

So manifold are the Branches of Culture that there can be no restriction to a uniform program, but primarily, effort should be made to establish worldwide interchange regarding local conditions, needs and possibilities for spiritual and physical regeneration.

To establish the equilibrium between the physical and spiritual development through continuous creative perfecting.

To lend assistance to all constructive efforts for international peace.

Participation in woman's organizations now existing must be regarded as especially helpful to participation in the Woman's Unity, which does not duplicate the efforts of other woman's organizations.

In this light it is hoped that the men and women of the world, who realize the great mission of womanhood in the cause of world evolution will aid this Fund, thereby sharing in the fulfillment of these noble aims. And in announcing this dedicated task we may also pronounce the call of Nicholas Roerich when he says, "In the language of the heart we greet you, Legion of Women and Lightbearers! Honor to your invincible enthusiasm! Voicing the name of the Himalayas, symbol of the most lofty summits, we offer you our full-hearted cooperation. We greet you in the joy of our mutual striving towards that most sublime and most imperative destiny of humanity. With you we shall attain!"
