Mister Chairman:

I am pleased to acknowledge receipt of yours dated December 2, 1933, in which, cognizant of the concern of the Conference of American States, for the preservation of the cultural traditions and monuments of the Americas, you begged this Conference to take favorable action on the unanimous recommendation of the Third International Convention for the Roerich Pact and Banner of Peace, - and with which you included copies of the Roerich Pact and Resolutions.

According to the Regulations of the International Conferences, new projects should be brought up to the Committee of Initiatives by one of the Delegations themselves, which fact accounts for our being unable to submit the Resolution of the Roerich Pact and Banner of Peace to the Conference. -
