TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

know ye, That reposing special trust and confidence in the integrity, prudence and ability of Henry A. Wallace, Secretary of Agriculture of the United States of America, I have invested him with full and all manner of power and authority, for and in the name of the United States of America, to meet and confer with any person or persons duly authorized by the Governments of other countries, being invested with like power and authority, and with them to sign a Treaty for the Protection of Artistic and Scientific Institutions and Historic Monuments, which will be opened for signature in the Pan American Union in accordance with a recommendation of the Seventh International Conference of American States, the same to be transmitted to the resident of the United States of America for his ratification, subject to the advice and consent thereto of the Senate of the United States of America.
