Lately, I informed my President Princess Alexandrine Gr. Cantacuzino, of my plans re: the adoption of the "Rorich Pact and Banner of Peace" by Roumania. My president was enthusiastic about it, and this letter is to ask you to be kind enough to send us as soon as convenient to you, all the necessary information about: the resolutions passed and especially the way by which this resolution is being put in practice in your country or in those who adopted it.

Having all these data, we shall proceed to organize a Public Festival Meeting in the presence of our Officials and the Diplomatic Corps, so as to show its real importance. Will you help us with any suggestions? sending us also if possible a message to be read on that occasion?

In April past, during his visit home, I informed our Minister in Washington, Mr. Charles Davila, about this my plan and he gave me his consent to inform officially our government about the Pact. Will you please write him in Washington and inform him also about your actual standing re: the Pact?

I am anxious to hear from you very soon, so as to arrange my festival meeting during the month of February or beginning of March.
