## Purpose:

- I) To collect and study draught resisting herbs.
- 2) To collect medicinal herbs and data on native pharmacopoeia. It is planned to visit Jehol and and districts ajacent to the Khingan Mots with the purpose of collecting the above mentioned data. during the summer months, devoting the winter months to the study of the collection at Harbin, Mukden, and Tokyo.

Prof. de Roerich, accompanied by Mr. Georges de Roerich, and the Japanese secretary of the Expedition, will proceed to Manchukuo about the 27th or 29th of May. The authorities and requested to grant a laissez passer permit through the Manchukuo Customs at Antung for their personal baggare consisting of 23 pieves of baggare containing personal effects and scientific books, as well as two typewriters, and one Mannlicher hunting rifle with 20 rounds of ammunitionn and one I2 bore shot-gun. Dr. Macmillan and Mr Stevens

are scheduled to reach Tokyo in the first weeks of june bringing with them the expedition equipment (botanical equipment, photographic supplies, tents, fire-arms and ammunition). The authorities are requested and extended ass stance during their passage through Japan to Manchukuo, as well as laissez-passer permits for their baggage at Yokohama and Antung.
