Sir,

As requested on May 28, 1935, the appointment of George N. de Roerich as Agent, \$4600 per annum in the Department of Agriculture Bureau of Plant Industry, New-York City, New-York effective July 1, 1935, for an additional period of one year, is approved under Schedule A, Subdivision I, paragraph 7, with the understanding that the appointee does not by such appointment acquire a competitive status, or become eligible for any other position or duties, and, if the position is within the scope of the Classification Act of 1923, as amended, that the salary of the position is to be (or has been) fixed according to the procedure under that act, before the appointment is made.
