

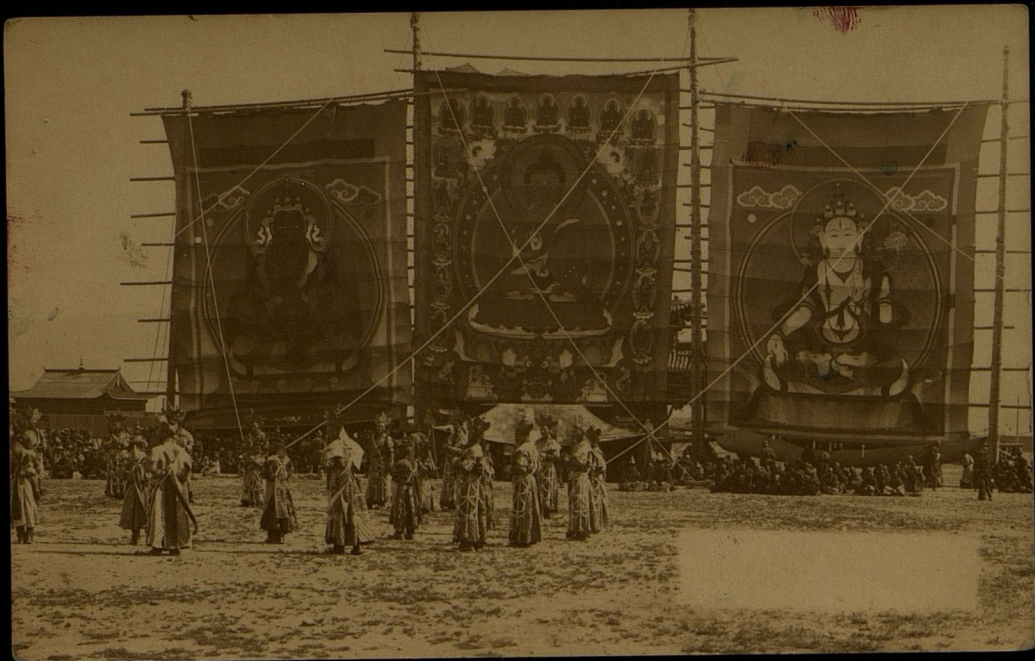

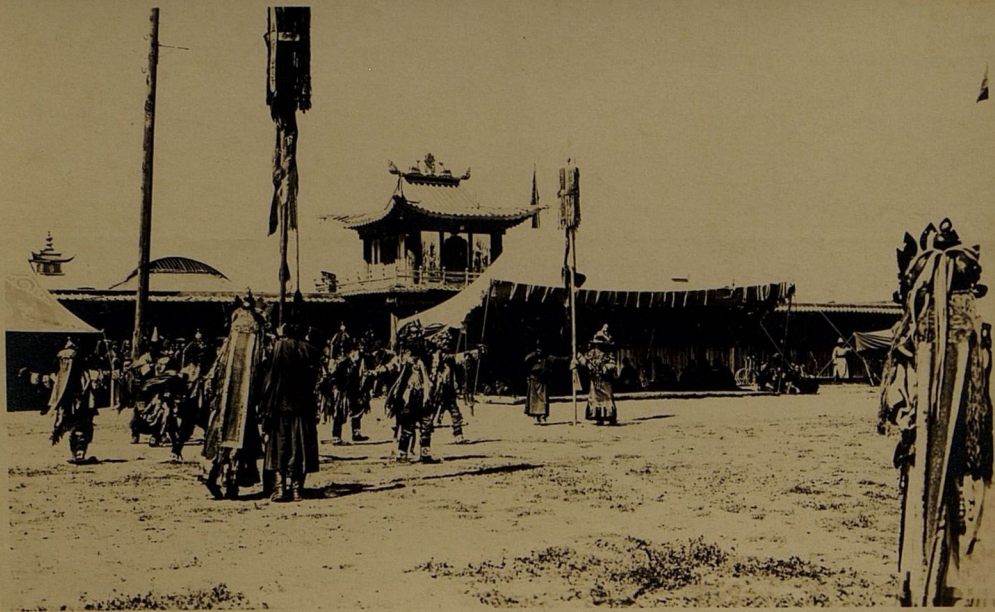
The three images represent: from left to right

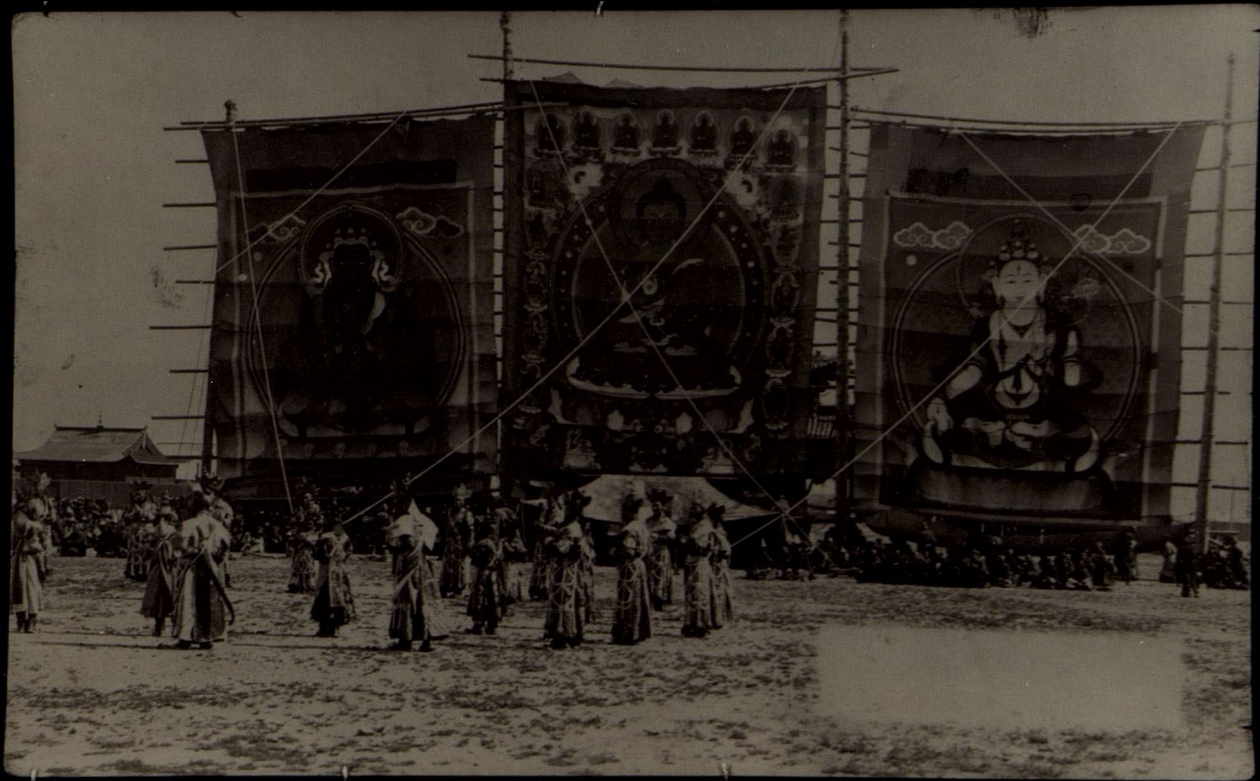
