My husband is receiving all FROM THE MYSORE GOVERNMENT TWO HONOURS, ONE FOR HIS BERVICE FOR ALL THE GOOD WORK HE HAS DONE IN INDIA, AND IN THE STATE OF MYSORE, IT IS CALLED THE "SPECIAL AWARD", AND IS GIVEN AT THE OFFICIAL DUSSERA FESTIVAL HERE IN THE STATE, AND ALSO FOR HIS ART AND CONTRIBUTION TO ART AND CULTURE. IT IS THE BEST DISTINCTION IN THIS STATE, GIVEN TO VERY FEW PEOPLE.

This is very good news indeed and it came just now to us. Everywhere it has been published, and our PRESIDENT OF INDIA HAS SENT HIS CONGRATULATIONS TO US ON THIS IMPORTANT NEWS ITEM.
