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My dear friend,

You will be happy to know that in Neggar in our Kulu Valley thousands of people gathered in our house where we have the Gallery containing the paintings of this Great Master, and they paid homage to also his Samadhi. It is so nice to have this tribute from these mountain people, simple, but full of faith. What better tribute could he have than their love and devotion. It is true that in the USSR. they have named two Glaciers after both Nicholas and Svetoslav Roerich just now, I do not know if it was to especially be at the time of Nicholas Roerich's 90th. anniversary, but is is certainly a fine thing is it not? The two hitherto uncharted Glaciers in the Kirghiz Alatau in the basin of the Alamedin River have been named after both Nicholas and Svetoslav Roerich. The All Union Geographical Society of the USSR. Leningrad sent us this news, and also the Monograph Publication Volume 96.- 1964. which contains the data.

I would like to have at least 6. copies of any issue of the Hindustan Times which covers his 90th. Birth Anniversary, and would be most grateful if you could instruct your Circulation Manager to send it to me by VPP. It is not late even now, as the Ministry of Culture USSR will only be ending this anniversary in about the middle of next year. In India also the National Book Trust of India is bringing out a nice Edition on the paintings of Prof. Roerich, and this will also take time.

We shall be going to Mysore just for a day or two, as they are giving to my husband 2. Awards. 1. For special service, and as a distinguished man in the State, and the other as an Artist of World Repute, which is very nice. This will be on the 16th. of October. But I shall be back on the 16th. night, or latest the 17th. morning. I hope you will write to me about all the above, as to how your paper may also publish something fine on this occasion.
