Thank you very much for your prompt reply to my letter to you the other day.

I have sent all the data to the people concerned and hope that they will have the Stamp of Nicholas Roerich sometime next year. As this is an important event not only here, but in other countries including the USA. and the USSR., it will be greatly appreciated if this Stamp comes out and I do hope the people concerned will have it done. The Minister was interested to have it done so I understand. Let us see. During the whole of 1964., and 1965, this anniversary will be observed, and in the USSR. so many books are being published during 1965 also. In France a fine book is being written, and in the USA. the Roerich Museum will also publish a fine book. The National Book Trust of India will be bringing out a book also with the paintings of Prof. Roerich.


