Thank you for your letter of the 4th. September which I am answering now, as we have unusally so many things which have to be seen to including the change of our office in town, which is now at No: 9. Edward Road, Bangalore.-1., We used to come here to my Mother's house which she lived in, and now have to change to this new place. We do not ofcourse stay here, but come here about three times a week, for our work, and to meet people who wish to meet us here, as it is too far for them to come out to our home in the country.
