We have found an old black and silver evening dress that used to be a sari and I have torn the thing apart, now the problem is to stick it together again so that I look something like my picture. Mummy and I went down to the Indian Bazaar and got all the jingling earring and

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bangles etc., and so far it seems to be getting on fine.

I am not looking forward to the terrific change in my way of living, and the Canadian people are really more foreign to me than the people out here. The winter will be the worst time and the thought of the cold is hanging over my head like the sword of Damocles and I am dreading it. The trouble with me is that I am a hot weather plant and the cold makes my nose red and my

temper bad !!
