My dear Mrs. Roerich,

This is to acknowledge your letters of August 25, Sept. 14 and Sept. 21, 1964. I am extremely sorry that due to various heavy pre-occupations I could not write to you until today. ^{last} This week I had been to Chandigarh to attend a meeting of the Advisory Committee on Journalism of the Punjab University. I propose to issue the text of Dr. Roerich's radio talk officially through the Press Information Bureau to all the newspapers in the country. Besides English, this will be issued in all the major Indian languages. I have spoken to Inderjit to release Vivek's article through service to all the papers which subscribe to INFA Service.

As you are aware, the Central Advisory Board of Education will be meeting in Bangalore from October 8 to 12. The plenary session will be held on October 11 and 12. The various standing committees of the Board will meet from October 8 to 10. According to my present programme I will be reaching on the afternoon of 7th October. I will be staying with Shri P.M. Raje, Public Relations Officer of HMT. Regarding the clippings from various papers, you need not worry. I shall certainly be able to supply you at least one set. As for purchasing copies of these papers, I can certainly make arrangements with the Central News Agency, New Delhi provided we know the papers which are ~~xx~~ likely to carry Shri Roerich's article.

I was delighted to know from your letter of September 21 that the two Russian glaciers had been named after Roerichs. It is indeed a very high honour and an international recognition of the world-renowned artists Nicholas and Svetoslav Roerich. Please accept my heartiest congratulations on this occasion. Mrs. Bowry and children also join me in sending you these hearty felicitations. I am greatly touched by the gesture of the USSR Government on this occasion.

We shall have a lot of things to talk when I meet you in Bangalore.
