the old place it will be a relief not to be tied to ones property too much. BUT when everything will be finished I do not know.

We are having a lovely time up here so far as the **meati** weather is concerned. The other day some friends and we three drove across to lat Pancho. It was a long drive, but when the top of the hill was reached we all stood lost in amazement. The Kinchanjunga group looked as though we could reach out and

touch it, and to the South the Plains were laid out like a map for miles and miles, lat Pancho is one of the cinchona plantatio tions, and the point from which we saw the view was about a couple of miles higher up. The road leaves the Teesta Valley road just near Kali Jhora.

We are all very fit and well up here, and are enjoying the approaching cold weather. I like it so much better than the heat, - even of Kalimpong!
