I can not tell you how the news of little
Coo being ill with amoebic dysentery
has upset us all. Anxiously we are watch-
ing your wife and hope she is better by now.
You are right our dr. Tulovants is very expe-
rienced and thoroughly acquainted with all
kind of dysenteries. This disease being very
common in our Turkestan where he has practised
almost for three decades. I know three hopeless cases
of amoebic dysentery which he has cured by nur-
sing ~~himself~~ the children himself. This disease
requires a special well trained nursing.

In case of high temperature warm baths are advis-
able but ~~it must be~~ greatest care must be
taken in order the child does not take cold.

Also in some cases he has applied with great success "compresses iodoformiques" (Iodine!) on the bowels but this must be skilfully done ^{and} with knowledge otherwise there is danger of taking cold.
