A year ago like a child I was learning to walk and talk. Not till the arrival of En did I understand certain things and not until

your letter did other certainties appear. A month ago a few days after the terrible letters had provoked profound melancholy I went to sleep and woke up with the intense desire to read Foundations of B. The passage beginning with page 131 especially impressed me. A few days later this intuition was confirmed by a letter from you.

Looking back I find that my faith has been greater that it should be and my action less. My whole instinctive approach has been different to many problems. But slowly, humbly, resolutely I am learning


to talk the language.
