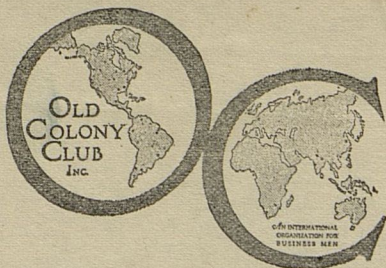

I feel very strongly that you are the great light of the school, that you are the great inspiration for all of us. Your smile will always be our great incentive, our encouragement and our reward!

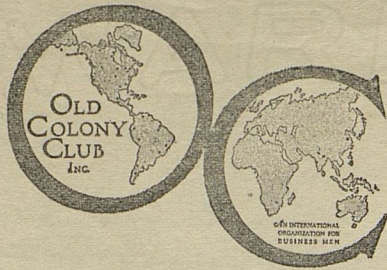
Through you the success of this great venture is unlimited and assured.

Oruān, the form in which the name of the  
 Jebusite King, who in the older record of the  
 book of Samuel is called Araunah, Aranyah  
 etc. is given in chronicles. The Jebusite nation  
 possessed Jerusalem before it was taken by the

of these 100,000 lb. worth of stock we will - at the start - sell 30,000 Dollars, and if we require to sell more later - we can do so.

The common stock (100,000 shares) with no par value will be given to the founders and some to the directors. The Preferred stock of which we will also keep the control will be retired within a short time; I mean we will buy the 30,000 Dollars back from the investors, probably within a year or two thru the earnings of the school.

I am sure that our plan is workable. It has the absolute approval of Master Moriah

and Master Numa, so we are going ahead along these lines.

Things are held up a little thru the lack of immediate funds for pre-organization expenses.

f. i. for incorporation fees and tax, lawyer fees - expense for literature, prospectus etc.; stenographer expenses, etc.

It is a small amount, probably about six hundred Dollars; but it is very necessary to have it in order to get things started at all.

For instance: We cannot interest anybody until we have an incorporated organization, it would not only be against the law but it would be very unbusinesslike.



Things here are progressing very favourably.  
I have practically finished the School Prospectus.  
I tried to follow out Master Rorrichs wishes and  
ideas as to the purpose of the school, etc. to  
my best ability. It may and probably will  
need some changes before it goes to the printer.  
I have not received a reply from Mrs Auertach as  
yet.

My plan is to incorporate under the laws of  
this state with a capital of 100,000 Dollars.

We will have 10,000 shares of 8% cumulat. Preferred  
stock at a par value of 10<sup>00</sup> per share.

We are not asking for donations and we are not a charity institution. We are a business institution and the foundation must be laid in a legal way. - It would be a bad policy to ask an outsider, I mean an investor like Otto Kahn & Co. to finance the pre-organization expenses, the odds and ends. We have to find other means. When we approach the investor we must have the proposition ready for him, we must have the stock-certificate to hand him for his money. Ça va sans dire!
