I write this letter on behalf of the Burmese Prince who resides in Kalimpong and is passing through a period of acute distress. As you know, the former Indian Government used to pay the Prince a monthly allowance, the payment of which was discontinued in March last, with the result that the Prince found himself without any means of livelihood. Some residents of Kalimpong are helping the Prince out, but the present arrangements cannot go on for a long time. The Prince is selling his furniture and books, but even this will carry him very far. I wonder if anything could be done to help him, and write this letter in the hope that you will find it possible to give us a suggestion.
