I am forwarding through your local agent the following items:-

Please keep the black paper on the prints, as this will protect the prints from deteriorating. It is suggested to make a block, size 12" x 8" (inches) in colour which would cost about Rs 600/=. One could then make prints as desired and in desired quantity. One thousand prints would cost several hundred rupees. To make the block one would require a good and sharp colour negative, size $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $2\frac{1}{2}$, taken with a Rolleiflex camera.
