Dear Dr. Uray,

Many thanks for your kind letter of the 2nd September. I also wish to thank you for having sent me your valuable offprints "Duplication, Gemination and Triplication in Tibetan", "On the Tibetan Letters Ba and Wa" and your reviews of Vorobyev-Desyatovsky's articles, as well as Volumes II-V of the Acta Orientalia of the ASH. I am much distressed to learn that Prof. Ligeti's article "Mots de civilisation de Haute Asie en transcription chinoise" in the Acta Orientalia, I, I, has gone out of print. Perhaps a copy will turn up. I am most interested in Prof. Ligeti's works and articles. I shall be grateful for books on nomad archaeology and for your choice of the books.

I have asked the Asiatic Society to send you the Blue Annals, Vol. I & II, and shall send vol. II to Professor Ligeti as you suggest. The books are going by registered bookpost and I hope will reach you in due course. I think I can still send you the issue of the Journal of the Asiatic Society containing my study on the Kesar Epic also the issue containing my article on Kun-mkhyen Chos-sku 'od-zer and the origin of the Mongol alphabet. The Journal of the Greater India Society is difficult to get and the 1945 volume containing my article is out-of-print. I shall send you on publication my Tibetan Grammar (the Central Tibetan dialect). A monograph on the Amdo dialect is also with the publishers. It will contain a Grammar of the Amdo dialect (Reb-kong sub-dialect), portions of the Kesar Epic in Amdo-wa, and a vocabulary in which besides the Amdo and Central Tibetan forms, I give the corresponding words in the Golok dialect (g'er-rta) and the Panaka.

I am sorry I do not know the present address of F.M. Miller.
