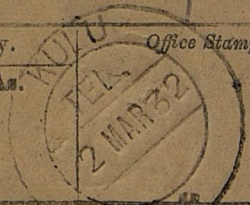

Dear Vladimir Anatolyevich,

Many thanks for your letter of the 19th instant, and for your letter of the 18th addressed to Professor Roerich. Also for the package containing newspapers, etc. which have been greatly appreciated. Should your Chief authorize another sending, we would appreciate it. The package containing 17 copies of "Literatura i Iskusstvo", and Uchitelskaya Gazeta, one Izvestiya, six Ogonyoks, and ten photos with a type-written note on the film, is being returned to your official address by registered parcel post.

You must have received our wire authorizing the reproduction of paintings in the monthly. We have also sent you two registered parcels containing Professor Roerich's "Joy of Art", my article on the Kesar Epic (a jubilee of the epic was planned in Russia recently), and some other material on art and art in the USSR. Please acknowledge receipt.

It is difficult to express an opinion about a film without seeing it. Some of their films with a Mongol background were excellent. Some of the shots seem to be excellent, for example the wrestling scene and the old lama. I enclose a brief note on Sukhe Bator. I shall be glad to write an article on the eastern regions of the Union.

I failed to find among the books sold by you to us here, the Russian Syntax and Grammar which you mention. I shall be glad to send on loan the Inturist Guide. Unfortunately we have no good photo of Tolstoi. A package containing several photographic albums had been left by you here, should I send it on to you?
