Dear Professor Roerich,

I am writing you on behalf of my friend Miss Chie Nakane of Tokyo University. She has this winter a scholarship in USA. Her address is: Dept. of Anthropology, University of Chicago, 1126 East 59th Street Chicago 37, Ill. She thinks that you may not want to receive a letter from USA. She is wrong, I am sure. This is anyhow what she says:

"May I ask you to contact Dr Roerich asking is there any possibility for me to stay one month after the Orientalist's Congress?
