Dear Friend,

As promised by me in Kalimpong at the Dinner Party which you were kind enough to attend at the invitation of my friend Sri Satiranjjan Sen on Sunday, the 27th December 1953, I am sending you our literature. If some money for initial expenditure be collected locally and a suitable house accomodating 25 to 30 children with about an acre of land be rented at a reasonable rent (appr. Rs. 100/- per month), I shall try my best to persuade the Government to bear the recurring expenditure of running an orphanage specially meant for the children of the soil. Other Welfare activities may also go on hand-in-hand. Local initial money and local initiative are needed for starting any work of this sort. I earnestly hope that you will extend a helping hand in this matter.
