CERTIFICATE OF CARGO INSURANCE

This is to certify that on the 7th day of June 19 55 insurance has been effected with this Company by Italian Consulate subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. The cover is in respect of loss or damage to the goods by any accident to the aircraft and/or to the surface conveyance and/or by fire, theft, pilferage, non-delivery, rain, freshwater and breakage (other than fragile articles) occurring during the currency of the certificate whilst in transit by air by the means thereon described, including loading and unloading risks and transit to and from the aerodrome of departure and the aerodrome of arrival respectively by surface transport for a distance not exceeding fifteen miles at each end and including also transit by surface transport to destination following any accident or misadventure to the aircraft carrying the cargo or whilst the goods are in the custody of the carrier subject to the time limit referred to in the open policy.

2. The insurance does not cover consequential loss howsoever arising or loss directly or indirectly attributable to leakage, contamination or pollution, wilful misconduct or negligence of the insured his servants or agents, delay, frustration, wear and tear or depreciation and deterioration, the action of moth or vermin, damage caused by cleaning, repairing or restoring defective or inadequate packing, inherent vice or defect (whether latent or apparent), earthquake, volcanic eruption, war, invasion, act of foreign enemy, hostilities (whether war be declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, riots, strikes, civil commotions, military or usurped power, sack or pillage, capture, seizure, arrests, restraints or detentions of all Kings, Princes and people of what nation, condition or quality soever or any attempt thereat (piracy excepted).

3. In the case of loss or damage immediate notice shall be given to: J. A. C. Kalimpang Airways (India) Ltd.'s Office.

4. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this insurance shall be referred to arbitration in Calcutta.

5. All other terms and conditions in accordance with the original open policy, a copy of which may be inspected on application to the Company delivering this certificate.
