My dear George,

Thank you very much for your letter which came here when I was away in Malaya and for the two books which you kindly returned. Bolitho's Jinnah is still with you and you send it to me as soon as you have finished it.

I spent a month in Kuala Lumpur and Singapore and you will be interested in the enclosed report which I gave to Dutt (I.C.S.), Secretary, Commonwealth Relations Ministry when I met him a fortnight ago in New Delhi. He said he would make a short summary of my note and my talk with him and place it before the Prime Minister. I couldnot see the Prime Minister as my stay in New Delhi was only for four days and his programme during those four days was so crowded that his Secretary could not squeeze me in.

Do you ever think of coming to Bombay and how is your work getting on? I am at last trying to settle down in Bombay to normal life after about 3½ months' travel.
