I have not yet been able to find the meaning of the two Nepali words which you told me. Neither I could locate Bhurkara Vihar nor could I find out the meaning of Humila.

However, I have found out something about Buddha Sena, Lord of Vajrasana. Their Kingdom was called Pithi and included the Gaya district. Some inscriptions of these Kings have also been found. ~~It~~ It is believed by the scholars that these Kings ruled near Gaya after the end of the rule of Lakshman Sena there. Thus we find that the statement of the Namthar about Buddha Sena is correct. This has made me more inquisitive to verify his statements about Nepal. Therefore, if there is no objection I shall be grateful

if you will kindly send me  
 extracts from your translation of the  
 Namthar relating to Nepal.  
 With the entire statement before  
 me I may be able to find out  
 more about it. Moreover, this  
 is a matter in which I am much  
 interested.
