Thank you for your letter dated 5th March. I was extremely sorry to hear, a short time ago, that you had lost your mother. Please accept my deepest sympathy.

Regarding ~~The~~ transcription for Dr. Liebenthal's Festschrift, I am afraid that at the Santiniketan Press we have only Roman, Bengali & Sanskrit types. We do have diacritical marks and there will be no difficulty about the use of the umlaut, but unfortunately we have no Greek type.

It would be best therefore if you could give Roman transcription as far as possible, although I know that this is not always satisfactory. If you would like to use some original Tibetan words it would, however, be possible for us to have line blocks <sup>made</sup> as long as the words are written out in clear calligraphy.
