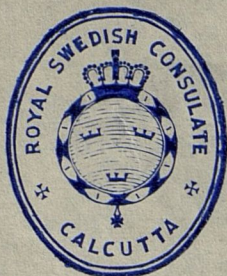

You will remember that Dr. T. Schmid, when she was in India last year, had arranged with the China Lama, Kathmandu, Nepal, for copies of the Tibetan Holy Book Tangyur to be sent to this Consulate for onward shipment to the University of Uppsala, Sweden. In a letter received by me from Dr. Schmid, she had mentioned that she had news from the China Lama to the effect that these books were on their way to Kalimpong where they would be checked by you as in the case of the last consignment. The University of Uppsala now write to me enquiring if I could give them any information as to where the books are at present and when they could be shipped from India.
