It gives me great pleasure to inform you that your name has been submitted to our Admission Committee.


This Committee will pass on all applications for membership now pending at a special meeting to be held on April 25th, and I would like to submit your application at that time.

The objects and purpose of the Society are stated in the Certificate of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State, State of New York, as follows:

- (a) To provide a social and fraternal medium by which members of the French Order of the Legion of Honor who are resident in the United States may co-operate in taking such action as from time to time shall seem to them likely to promote and uphold the prestige and standards of said order.
- (b) To encourage in the United States studies relating to France, its customs and people; to promote appreciation in the United States of French works, and in France of American works, and generally to do everything tending to strengthen friendship between the peoples of the United States of America and France.
- (c) To acquire such property, real or personal, as may be expedient for the due and proper fulfillment of these purposes.
