My dear Professor,

I am sorry it has not been possible to write to you earlier on the subject of your book "Himalayan Lights".

Pandit Vyas and I have consulted the printers and the local paper merchants with the following result.

As paper in Royal size was not possible to obtain we thought that subject to your approval the book could be printed in Demy 8vo size, and we have consequently obtained quotations for printing in that size. I enclose one forme of printed matter to give you an idea of the size of the page as well as the typography, page-measure etc., which we would recommend for the book.

I enclose estimates from two of our best printers, viz., the Indian Press and the Allahabad Law Journal Press, for the printing of the book. The comparative rates are:

	Indian Press	A.L.J.Press
Printing per page for the first 1000 copies	Rs 2/-	Rs 1/8/-
Printing subsequent 1000 copies per page	-/8/-	-/5/-

As the Allahabad Law Journal Press are in our opinion better printers and have also quoted more favourably we prefer to entrust the printing to them.

According to estimates given by the press the book is likely to run into 448 pages (more or less) in the size as per specimen enclosed.

The binding charges in paper cover would be about \$70/- per 1000 copies. The cost of binding in full cloth owing to rise in the cost of binding material would be anything from \$35/- to 40/- 100 and is quoted subject to fluctuations. In case you decide to have 2000 copies printed we suggest that 1500 copies be bound in paper cover and 500 copies in full cloth. It would make a very slight saving if paper boards are used instead of full cloth. The same proportion of copies of the two kinds may be maintained even if 1000 copies are printed. Naturally if 2000 copies are produced the price per copy would be cheaper.

I personally consulted Mr. K.Dar of the A.L.J.Press regarding cover design. He said it would be an impertinence to make suggestions to such a person as you. He however thought that a two-colour line design would come out very well.

At the last moment we were informed that paper in demy size was also not in stock with local paper merchants. I accordingly met the local Agent of the Titaghur Paper Mills and have formally written to him for the supply of paper sufficient for 2000 copies. As the proceeds are to be donated to the Russian Red Cross I was assured that the Director of the Mills at Calcutta might treat the order as for war purposes and release the required quantity at mill rates. Should you wish to print only 1000 copies half this supply could easily be disposed off. I am hoping for the supply of paper now. I enclose copy of my letter to the Mills.

My dear Professor,

I have sent you a telegram yesterday as follows:

ROERICH NAGGAR
TITAGHUR OFFER WHITE PRINTING DEMY HUNDRED REAMS MILL RATES
NO ALTERNATIVE WIRE
TANDAN

I send herewith copies of letters which have passed between Messrs Titaghur Mill & Co. Ltd., and myself which will explain to you the situation. The position is that I have booked 120 reams of demy white printing paper on your behalf and paid the Mills a total sum of R952/6/-from my personal account.

As the paper had been offered to us subject to intermediate sale and the heavy demand for paper was within my knowledge, as a matter of precaution I have booked this quantity of paper. This however leaves you under no obligation. Should you decide not to use this paper or use only part of it the whole or balance could be easily disposed off.

I have not had your reply to my telegram till the time of writing. I would be much obliged if you please write to me in detail in reply to my last letter and if there is anything urgent to instruct send a wire.

The non-availability of paper in double demy size would entail an additional printing cost of -/3/-per page per 1000 copies. Should you wish the proofs to be finally passed at Allahabad - and that would save time - a sum of about %100/- would have to be incurred.

My dear Professor,

I sent you a telegram yesterday as below:

"ROERICH NAGGAR
DISCUSSED WITH KITABISTAN WILLING TAKE
UP PUBLICATION IMMEDIATELY IF PAPER
OUTSIDE THEIR QUOTA ALLOWED LETTER
FOLLOWS

TANDAN" .

I have since had this letter from Mr. Rehman of the Kitabistan which I enclose in the original.

The Kitabistan have already paper of good bulk in their stock but cannot use it under government restrictions allowing them only a 30% of their former quota. So all they need is a permit from the Secretary to the Government of India, Civil Supplies Department, that they are allowed to exceed their quota by the quantity of paper required for publishing the book. They will of course have to abide by the restrictions laid down in the Paper Control Order in respects of margins, etc.Mr. Rehman will however specially look to the get-up of the book.
