Dear Prof. del Boca,

I was glad to have your letter of July 3rd and I take this opportunity to send you a brochure on Prof. Nicholas Roerich which may be helpful to you in your research. The bibliography on Prof. Roerich is very vast but a great deal of it is out of print unfortunately. A new biography has been just published in the Soviet Union written by F.F. Belicov and Madame Kniazeva. Mr. Belicov is an Art Critic and she is the Research Scholar of the Russian Museum of Art at Leningrad. The book is in the series of "The Lives of Remarkable Men" initiated by the famous Writer Maxim Gorky and these books are usually brought out in very large number of copies. This particular biography is one hundred fifty thousand copies. A number of other books are in preparation in the Soviet Union, they will all come out towards the Centenary Celebrations of Prof. Roerich's birth in 1974.

My Brother the late Dr. George Roerich was in charge of the Scientific work of the Himalayan Research Institute at Naggar, Kulu. This work was originally initiated by my Father Prof. Nicholas Roerich.
