My dear Svetoslav,

Thank you very much for your message of greetings conveyed to us through Mr. Hiten Chaudhry.

We are delighted to know that you are now in Bombay and will continue to be there for some time. Both of us expect to fly from here on or about February 16 - 18, 1949, by the TWA. It really would be marvellous to see you and Devika and to spend a few hours with you before we fly to Delhi. If Geeta Sarabhai happens to come to Bombay we might be able to stay a day or two in her flat; otherwise we shall not add to the refugee problem.

I understand Mme Roerich and George are also in Bombay. If that is so, we shall be able to have the very good fortune of meeting them as well.

I wish to consult you on so many matters and to have the benefit of your guidance on several literary projects I am engaged in.

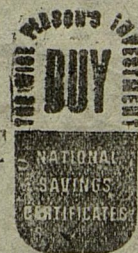
