The Inter-Asian Art Exhibition will be opened by Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, Minister-in-Charge, Education and Art Department, Government of India, at 3 p.m. on the 24th March 1947, before the representatives of foreign Governments and Indian personalities. Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru has kindly agreed to interpret his speech in English before the gathering.

3. The second All India Art Conference will be held on the 25th and 26th March 1947 at the premises of the Society. Apart from the representatives of the various Art Societies, the Society have sent invitations to the important artists and art critics of India and Ceylon.

4. You are invited to be present at the opening of the Exhibition and the Conference.

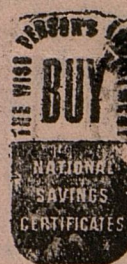

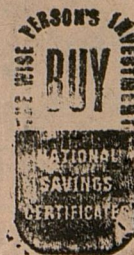
