Object: To investigate nature of "inner illumination".

Method: Camera Dark Room.

Experimenter Stool

Developer
Wash
Fixative
Wash
Wash

Velox printing paper - sealed pack.

## Procedures

Dark Room.

Meditation on development of light (3rd ventricle).

Break seal of pack, extract 2 pieces of paper.

Place one piece of paper on stool, sensitized face up.

Hold 2nd piece one inch in front of eyes - sensitized

surface toward eyes.

Project light ("inner illumination")
10 seconds.

Place paper in developer - then in wash, then in fixative, then in wash and finally in running bath for half hour.

Develop paper on stool at same time.

This paper acts as a scientific control to show that the image does not exist (?) in the room, as such.
