This address will find him. He appears to be about 26 or at most 30 years of age. Was dedicated by his mother to the service of "The Mother of the World".

He was educated at Harrow, England, (a public school which receives only the sons of nobility). He belongs to a princely family in India. —

He, of his own free will, has consecrated his life to "The Mother of the World, the World-Mother".

He has recently terminated a fast lasting 81 days during which time, he drank no water, no liquid at all, & took no food of any kind whatsoever. He walked six miles every day, slept six hours in the 24, performed all his usual religious practices, experienced no diminution of power, and physicians' deprecation. He was closely watched by four doctors during the fast. On the 81st day, a slight bleeding at the nostrils occurred, whereupon the doctors forbade the continuation of the fast. — He is now allowed to take disciples, but his own attainments are not completed, he says. He will soon disappear to resume his studies & contemplation. ...

When 15, he was bitten by a mad dog. A Swami from Tibet saw him & saved him: his mother promised to consecrate her son to God if the Swami saved him. Therefore, he accompanied this Swami to Tibet.

This Swami's name is: Swami Anand Paramahansa. He is still alive & in the same monastery. He is very much over one hundred years old. He comes to India (Benares) once a year to establish contact: a duty laid upon all the great hermits across the border, in the Himalayas. - His monastery is at Gyan Gung, near Manasarowa, Tibet.

In that same monastery is a Master who is said to be the Master K.H. He is called there:

Swami Bhriwaran Paramahansa. He is over 1,400 years old. He appears & disappears abnormally, at will, & instantaneously.

The nearest town to this monastery is Jullundur (Kashmir border). The disciples of Swami Bishudhanand often see parcels addressed to him bearing the post-mark of Jullundur. He receives all his lenses (crystals) from this monastery.

Swami Bishudhanand lived 20 years in this monastery - (which is devoted to Science) - . Then he received orders to return to Calcutta & practice as a doctor & thus gain independence. He did so for a few years, with great success & earning a fortune. He was recalled to Tibet, after, I think, five years (which time was only a period of probation). He then spent another 20 years in this monastery. He was sent back to India (Benares) only a few (3 or 5) years ago with the mission

to teach the Science, or Sciences, he had learned in Tibet. - to bring the Knowledge of the same to the West. - When his laboratory is ready - (in at most two years from today) - he is to invite the great professors of the West to visit his laboratory & study there for themselves.

He is able to levitate himself, disappear & reappear at will, make any thing almost instantaneous - (perfumes, sweets, flowers, jewels, crystals: - his body is said to be a mass of crystals) - by the action of the sun's rays. His disciples have built ^{him} under his direction, a large house & laboratories, to be called: "The House, or Temple, of the Sun". He calls his Science: Surga Begyan: Science or Knowledge of the Sun.

He says that every phenomenon is due to the sun's action.

This Swami says he is patiently waiting for his mission to be fulfilled, when he will be allowed to retire from the world altogether, returning to the monastery, from there, unknown, to work for the enlightenment of humanity.

He speaks Bengale & Tibetan. I found he had the power of making me understand his spoken words, though I do not know Bengale or Tibetan.

He is not prepossessing in appearance; but his disciples are all eminently superior men - (Doctors & lawyers) - who appear to hold him in high veneration & esteem. Many have been his close students for 3-4 years & are hoping to acquire power to produce the same results ^{the Swami produces}.
