PLEASE TELL THE PRESIDENT AND MINISTERS I VERY MUCH PRIZE THE
HONOR THEY ARE DOING ME STOP THE WELFARE OF THE CHINESE PEOPLE
HAS BEEN OF GREAT CONCERN TO ME FOR MORE THAN HALF A CENTURY
STOP THE PEACEFUL SITUATION ALL AROUND THE PACIFIC OCEAN THE
LAPSE OF SERIOUS UNFRIENDLY PRESSURE FROM EUROPE RUSSIA AND
JAPAN THE STRONG ALMOST UNDISPUTED INTERNAL POSITION AND THE
FINE BODY OF DEVOTED UNDERSTANDING MEN AND WOMEN AT NANKING
ALL WARRANT THE UTMOST OPTIMISM STOP MAY THEY CONTINUE TO DRIVE
STRONGLY AHEAD WHILE EVERYTHING IS SO FAVORABLE AND PUT CHINA IN
A POSITION FREE OF MENACE FOR FIVE HUNDRED YEARS ENABLING HER TO
MAKE HER OWN PRICELESS CONTRIBUTION TO THE NEW WORLD WE ARE ALL
