Re: Policy No. 25843 insuring Ford Car
No. BMZ-7541 belonging to Mrs. K.S. Campbell

We have received your letter of the 22nd November 1951 and would inform you that the Motor Policy contains a provision that where a car is laid up in garage and not in use for a period of two or more consecutive months, the liability of the Company can be restricted to loss or damage by fire and theft only and in consideration of the reduced risk a return premium, calculated on a pro rata basis, may be credited to the insured for deduction from the next renewal premium after charging a premium for the restricted period at 1 anna % on the insured value per month or part of a month, subject to a minimum of Rs.5/- provided previous notice in writing is given to the Company by the Insured and provided further that the Certificate of Insurance is returned to the Company.

In the present case, however, as the conditions prerequisite for allowing a refund have not been observed, we regret that we are unable to do anything in the matter.

However, we are prepared to issue a new policy insuring the car against Fire and Theft Risks only whilst in garage at a premium of Rs.52-8-0 the same to be cancelled and a new Comprehensive policy issued when the car is again taken out for use.

We await your advices.

Thank you for your prompt and comprehensive answer.
